- Winter horse blankets – any sizes ranging from weanling to draft; please contact for exact sizes and amounts needed.
- Leg wraps for warmth
- Extra ShelterLogic corrals and shelters
- Extra feed, hay, bedding, and volunteers are greatly needed and appreciated in the Winter months; the MO cold takes a toll on the animals as well as the rescuers during these times. We also get an influx of neglected horses during Fall/Winter.

Occasional Needs:
